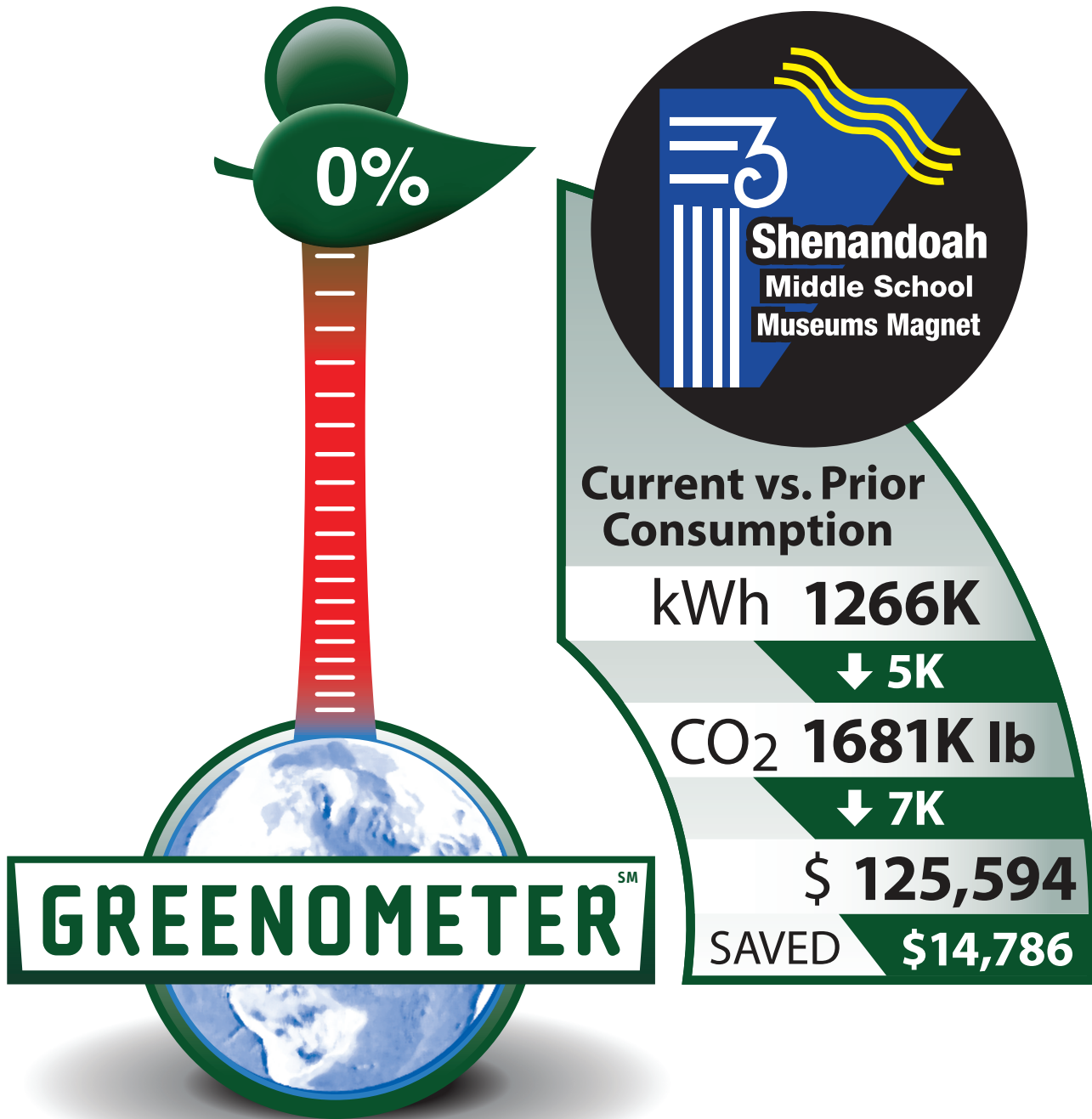


Participating School:

The Green Schools Challenge (GSC) engages school teams in reducing the carbon footprint of their schools and homes through reducing energy, waste, water, and by planting trees. Each participating school receives a Greenometer which measures the amount of carbon dioxide the school reduced by conserving electricity and recycling. The dashboard shows a comparison of kilowatt hours, carbon dioxide, and money spent on electricity during the current school year (from September 2008 to March 2009) versus the previous school year (from September 2009 to March 2010).

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
