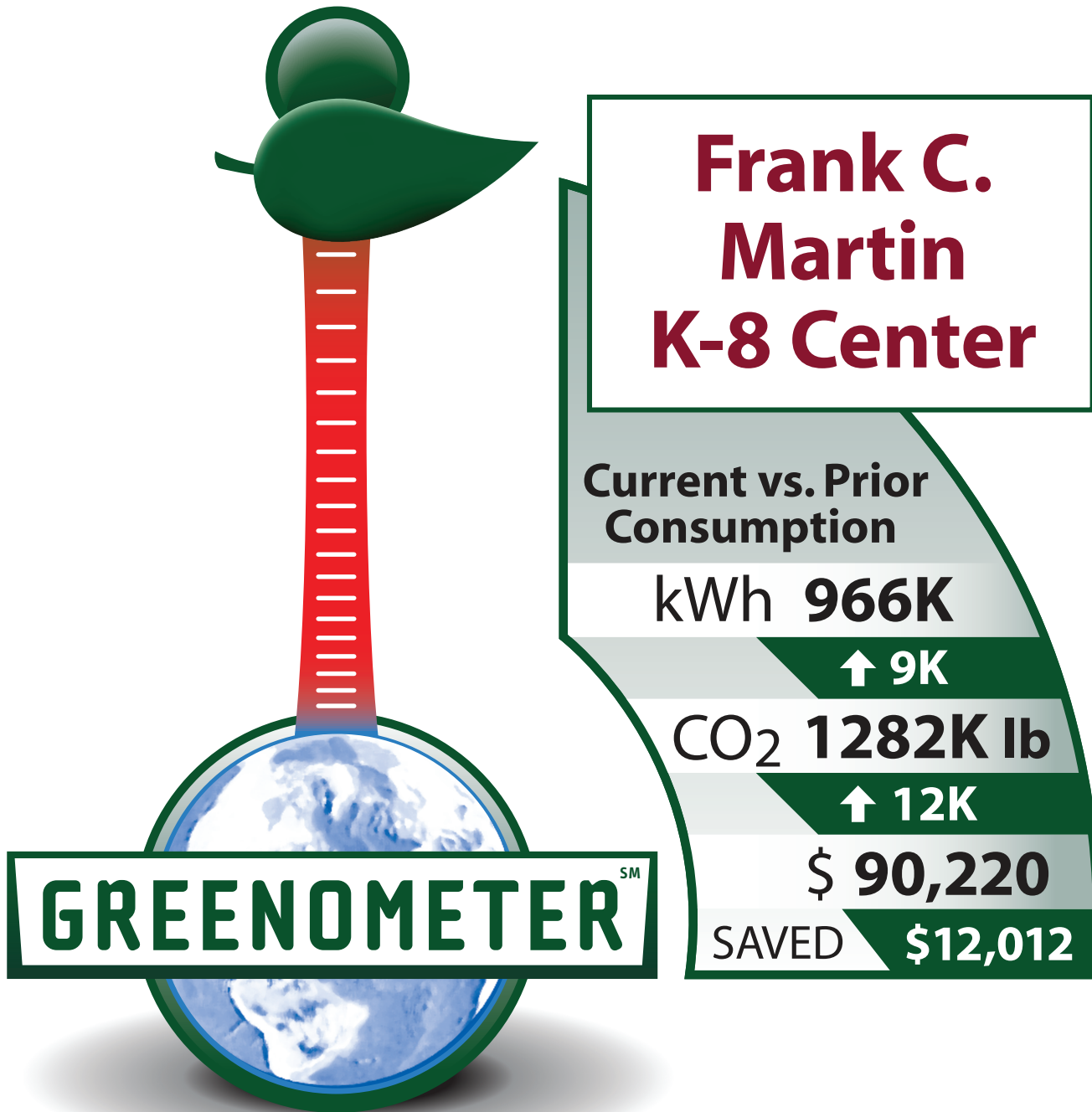

The Green Schools Challenge (GSC) engages school teams in reducing the carbon footprint of their school and homes through reducing energy, waste, water, and by planting trees. Each participating school receives a Greenometer<sup>SM</sup> which measures the amount of carbon dioxide the school reduced by conserving electricity and recycling. The dashboard shows a comparison of kilowatt hours, carbon dioxide, and money spent on electricity during the current school year (from September 2009 to March 2010) versus the previous school year (from September 2010 to March 2011).
